Gestational Diabetes?

Gestational diabetes is a type of diabetes that occurs during pregnancy and develops when the pancreas is unable to make enough insulin to cover your needs during pregnancy. It can be hard to detect because there are usually no symptoms. Most health care providers recommend screening all pregnant women between 24 and 28 weeks of pregnancy. If you are diagnosed with gestational diabetes, your doctor will refer you for self-management education.
