What is Cardiac CT Calcium Scoring?

It is a simple, non-invasive scan that measures the amount of plaque in your coronary arteries, allowing your doctor to determine your score, or risk.



What does the score

mean? Your score is used to predict your three-to-five-year risk for heart attack or heart disease. Based on your score your doctor may make health, lifestyle or medication recommendations.

What's your score?

To find out, ask your doctor if Cardiac CT Calcium Scoring is right for you. A physician referral is required.
